**CALLING ALL THRIVENT MEMBERS!** Did you know that you can get \$\$ to benefit the ministries of Hope Lutheran Church, just by leading an ACTION TEAM. It’s easy! If you are a Thrivent policy holder you have 2 opportunities to receive \$250 in “Seed Money” for a project. The money can be used for a fundraiser, service activity or for education (sharing knowledge on a topic). In order to receive the money you have to go online to apply. A project must be completed within 90 days of the application. After the project is complete you must go online and complete a simple report on the project. Once approved, within 5 days, you will be mailed an information packet which includes a \$250 Visa “Community Project Card.” When completing the application you can order up to 25 “Live Generously” t-shirts and other resources.
